







School training model prevails in Lithuanian VET system.

Dual model is known in Lithuania, however is not used systematically, restricted to educational institutions, within the framework of individual projects





- In the situation then birth rate is declining, demographic crisis is deepening, higher education should pay more attention to the continuous vocational training. Informal training of employees to be carried out according to a flexible schedule, easily compatible with the working time.
- At present the most realistic approach is to adapt the dual training model not in core university, but in ongoing, training studios, according the lifelong learning strategy.
